Farmers Favourite Tree Challenge

The ANU Sustainable Farms project invites entries for the Farmers Favourite Tree Challenge. The Challenge aims to highlight a photo of a spectacular or special tree each month in our 2021 Calendar. Photos and stories entered in this challenge may be featured in the 2021 Calendar and used for other communication material.

All entries must include a photo of the tree (an image taken on your phone is fine) and 1-2 paragraphs about the tree. Entries must be submitted via email to sustainablefarms@anu.edu.au. Entry is limited to a total of two (2) trees per person.

Entries should aim to:

- Have a visually appealing tree in the landscape (the image quality is not as important as the tree itself and its story).
- All trees must be located within our project area (see map on next page).
- Trees will be judged on their story, what they mean to the farmer and their biodiversity value. Sustainable Farms may also take a for-purpose photo of the chosen tree(s).

Selected entrants will have their tree featured in the calendar, and will receive a printed copy of the final photograph as well as a copy of the calendar.

Terms and conditions of entry

1. The challenge is open to any landholders in the Sustainable Farms project area.
2. The judging panel will be comprised of representatives from the Sustainable Farms team and the Fenner School of Environment and Society at ANU. Their decision will be final.
3. All entries must be submitted via email to sustainablefarms@anu.edu.au. Entry is limited to a total of two (2) trees per person.
4. Entries must comprise a photo of the tree (quality of photo is not important) and 1-2 paragraphs about what the tree means to the farmer, the tree's story and the entrant's perspective on the tree's biodiversity value.
5. Submitted photographs and stories may be featured in the 2021 Calendar and used for other Sustainable Farms communication material, including on social media.
6. By submitting an entry, entrants agree to license and grant Sustainable Farms and the Fenner School a non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide right to use, reproduce, modify, adapt, publish and display all or part of the entry for Sustainable Farms communication and engagement purposes, without compensation, restriction on use or liability.
7. If an entrant's tree is selected, the entrant agrees to having further photographs taken of the tree, by a Sustainable Farms staff member or their representative, on a day suitable to the entrant during August or September 2020.
8. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
9. The closing date for entries is ~~5pm Friday 14th August 2020~~ extended to midnight Sunday 23rd August 2020. Entries received after the closing date will not be accepted.
